On Friday, April 11, we gathered and explored two mission sites. First we toured the Wesley Education Center. It is National Mission site located in Cincinnati. After lunching together, we then went to visit The Wesley Foundation which is located on the campus of the University of Cincinnati. I was very impressed with the Wesley Education center. It was a clean, organized and lovely space, providing wonderful learning opportunities for the children of the community.



On the first of two District Mission Trips I learned about the work and the needs of Wesley Education (one of our 90 National Mission institutions) and Wesley Foundation (the only Wesley Foundation remaining in Ohio). Wesley Education Center is completely remodeled, costing \$1.5 million. The Wesley Foundation owns and operates 2 houses in the UC community where student housing is provided. They also are partnering with Wesley Campus Ministry in Oxford, OH.

Both of these important missions are in need of volunteers and donations. I loved when Carla Butler at Wesley Education Center said welcome to YOUR building. The United Women in Faith and our predecessor organizations purchased the land and built the Education Center in 1920. It is the oldest daycare/preschool program in Cincinnati.
