Joining in Book Discussions in the New Year

We have many opportunities to review and discuss the books selected for our Reading Program. This year, we are going to use the resources available to us, including a new collaboration with The West Ohio Conference.

Emily Jones, UWF's Executive for Racial Justice – (Ending Mass Incarceration & Criminalization of Communities of Color and Priority Lead Liaison for Conference Social Action Coordinators) has invited us to the Book discussion We Are Not Here to be Bystanders: A Memoir of Love and Resistance by Linda Sarsour on 2/24, 7:00 p.m. You need to register to attend the virtual event.

Introducing a new connectional collaboration with The West Ohio Conference, led by Julie Carter, Director of Faith Formation and Lay Ministry. Each month, the Expanding Connections Book Club meets via Zoom to discuss the month's book selection. In this new partnership, we are inviting our UWF community to join people from all over West Ohio as we Expand our Connection with one another and people we haven't met yet. Each month, our book selections will be diverse, accessible, and empowering. This community of readers will be a hub promoting equality, equity, and inclusion and share the stories of the world to generate empathy and peace through books. Books will be announced the 15th of each month and a time for gathering and sharing will take place around the same time.

The Wesley Dayton Baby Ready/Infant Mortality Program started 2024 with about 26 participating families and enrolled 45 more during the year. There were 46 healthy births and one who was not so fortunate. BRIM staff provides individualized assistance for everyone to address the unique situation of each family. Laughter and tears run close together.

Two Baby Showers were held to highlight family readiness, and two First Birthday/ Graduation parties to recognize their accomplishments. In addition to one-onone meetings, mothers also participated in learning activities such as safe sleep, car seat safety, nutrition, financial literacy, job readiness, birth plan writing, birth basic classes, and peer support groups. Many also brought their whole family to meet Santa at the Baby's First Christmas Party. All expressed their appreciation for the BRIM staff's practical encouragement as well as the many nice gifts, such as, the laundry baskets filled with new baby items, literacy kits, diapers, baby safety gates, and handmade treasures (e.g., prayer shawls, blankets and hats).

We carry 71 families into 2025, with an anticipation of 5 baby deliveries before the end of January. Our 2025 goal is to have 85 total moms actively enrolled and receiving services from our program. In-kind and financial support from community organizations encourages the staff and enables us to provide both tangible and intangible assistance to those we serve. Together we are making a positive difference in West Dayton!
